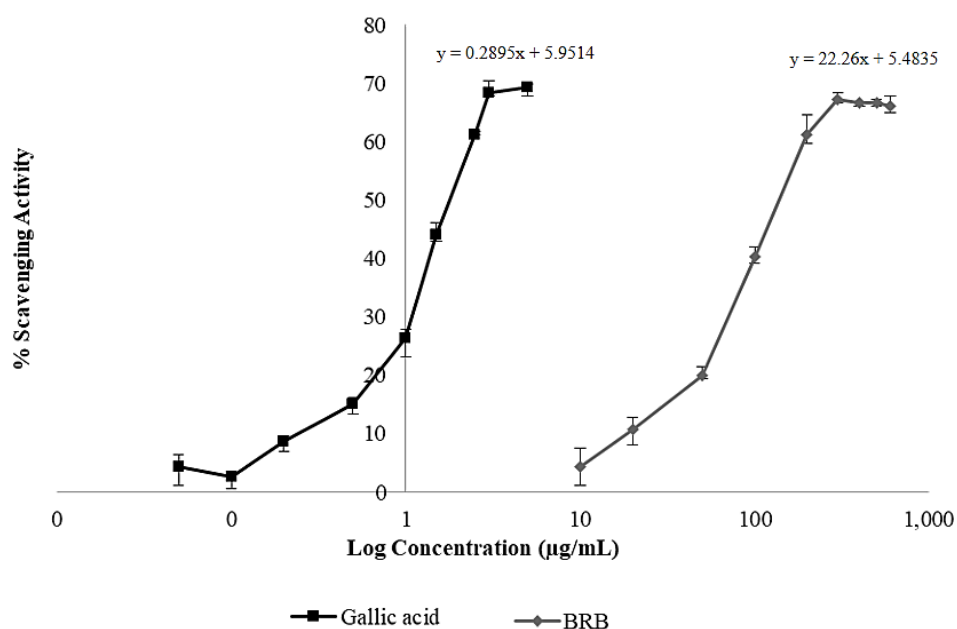


Figure S1. The log concentrations and % DPPH radical scavenging activities of ethanol extract of BRB and gallic acid.
