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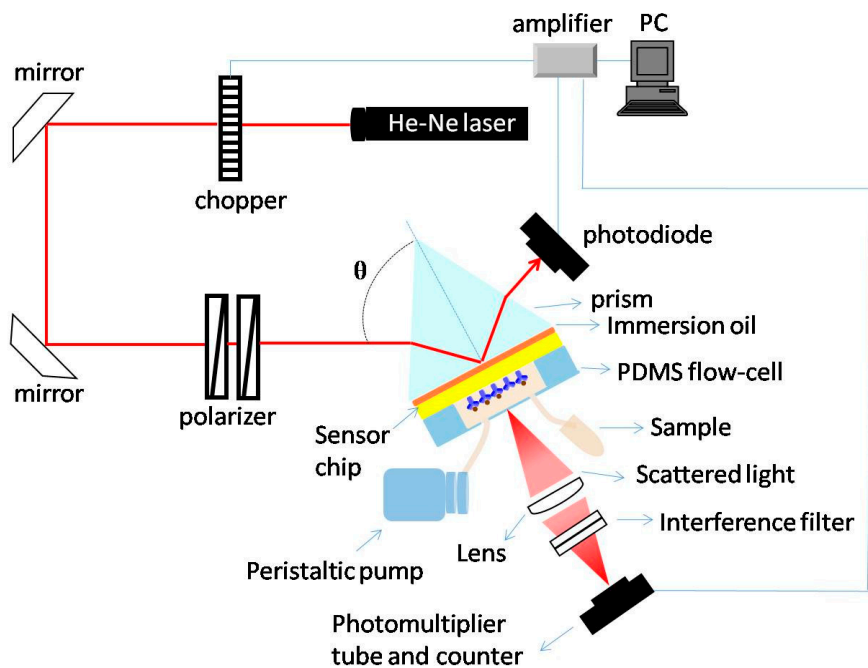


Figure S1. Optical setup of SP-LS in this study.

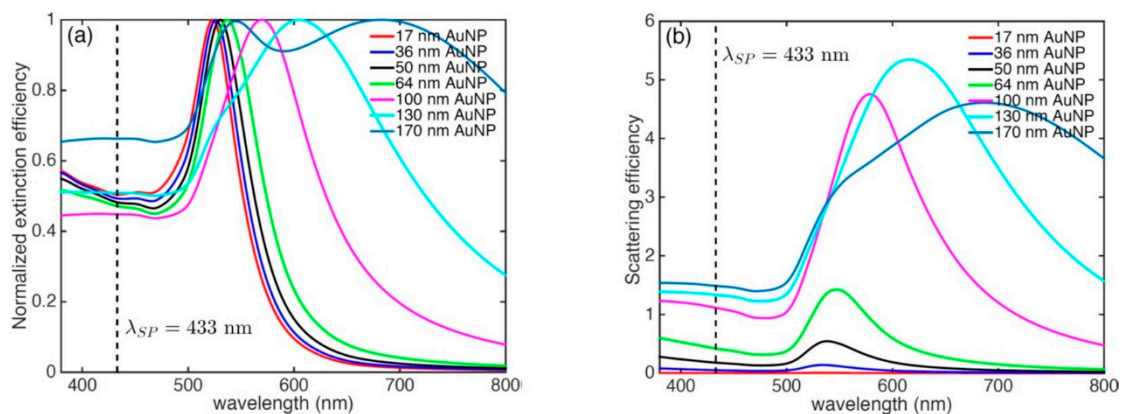

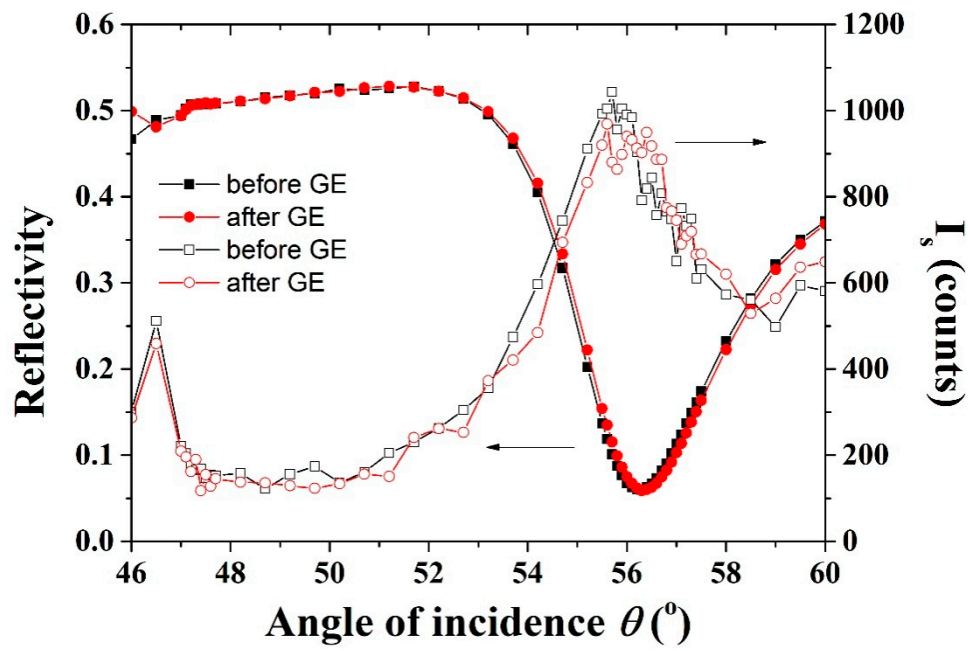
