exit criteria

1. Symptomatic cases
 - a. 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms and 72 hours have passed after the symptoms have abated.
 - b. 24 hours after symptom resolution, and two negative PCR test results are obtained at least 24 hours apart.
2. Asymptomatic carriers
 - a. 10 days have passed from the date of specimen collection.
 - b. After 6 days have passed from the date of specimen collection, two negative PCR test results are obtained at least 24 hours apart.
