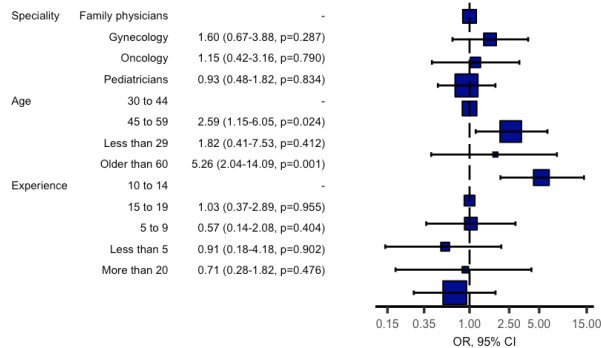
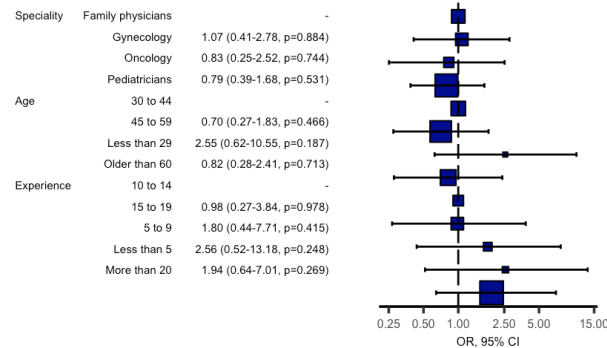


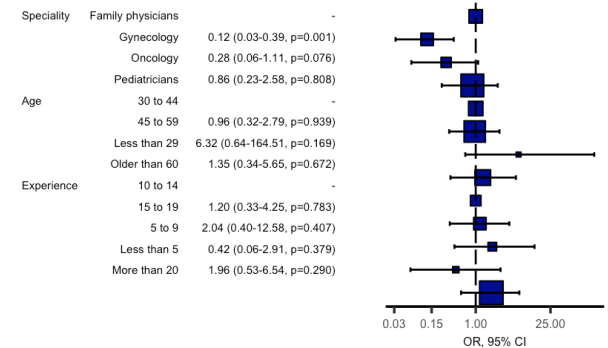
HPV is relatively uncommon.: OR (95% CI, p-value)



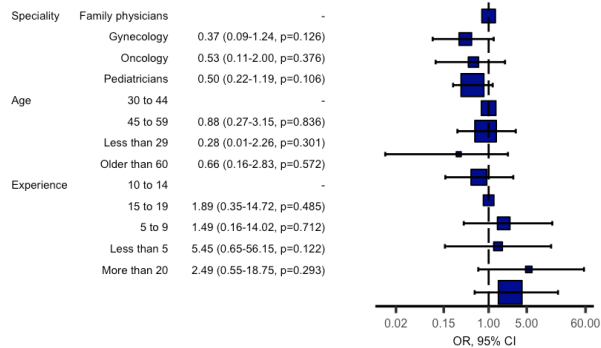
Almost all cervical cancers are caused by HPV: OR (95% CI, p-value)



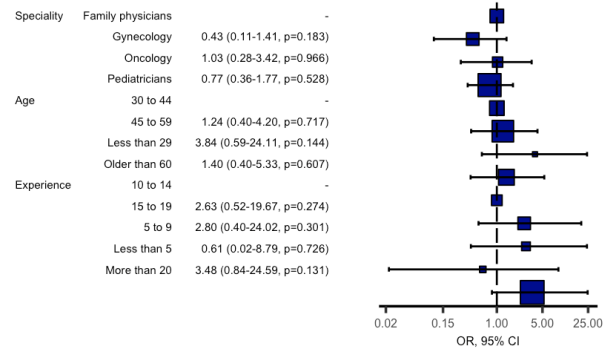
HPV is most common in women in their 30s: OR (95% CI, p-value)



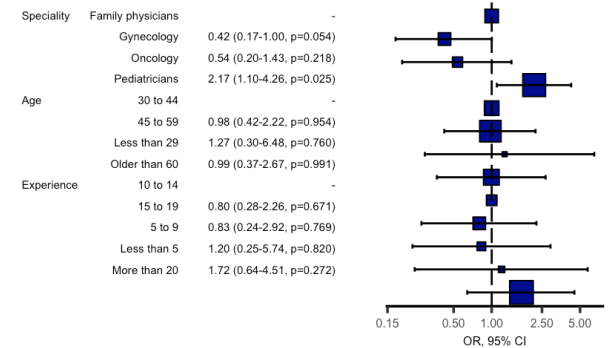
Cervical cancer is one of the most prevalent cancer among woman: OR (95% CI, p-value)



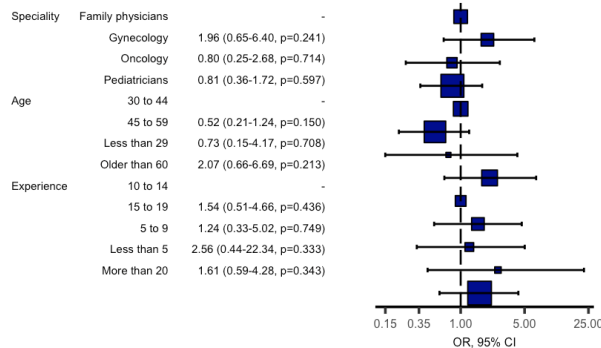
Most people with genital HPV are symptomatic: OR (95% CI, p-value)



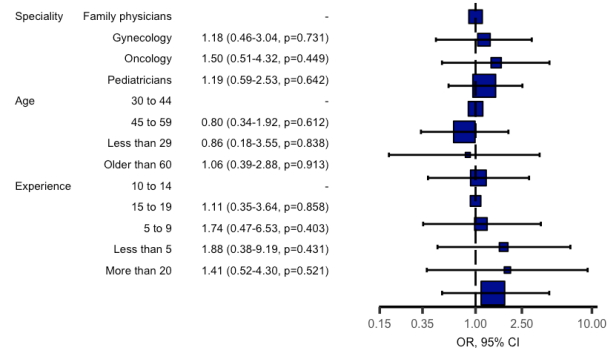
Genital warts are caused by the same HPV types that cause cervical cancer: OR (95% CI, p-value)

Men and women who have been diagnosed with HPV should not be given HPV vaccine: OR (95% CI, p-value)

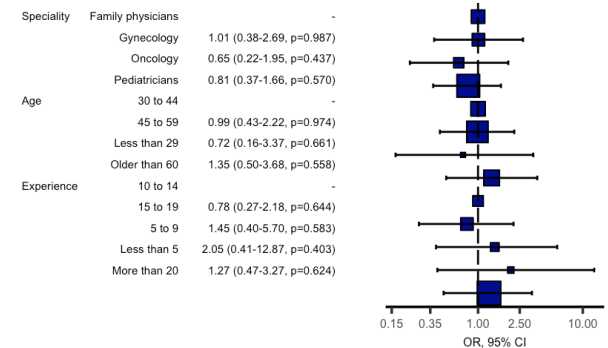
