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Supplementary Figure S1. Anti-inflammatory effects of alverine in an *in vivo* acute gastritis model. Mice were pretreated with alverine (0–200 mg/kg) orally twice per day for 3 days then injected orally with EtOH/HCl (150 mM). (A) mRNA expression levels of iNOS, TNF- α and GAPDH in stomach tissues were examined using RT-PCR. (B) Total and phosphorylated protein levels of I κ B α , p65, p50, iNOS, and β -actin were analyzed using a Western blot analysis.
