



Figure S3: Typical neuropathological hallmarks of CJD and its comorbid diseases: (A+B) PrP-positive kuru-like plaques may be found in some CJD cases. (C) Extracellular cored neuritic A β plaques are characteristic for Alzheimer's disease as well as (D) cerebral amyloid angiopathy. (E+F) Astrocytic inclusions characterize aging-related tau astrogliaopathy (magnification 100x and 400x, respectively). (G) Neurofibrillary tangles are crucial for neuropathological diagnosis of primary age-related tauopathy. (H) α -synuclein positive Lewy bodies define Lewy body dementia.
