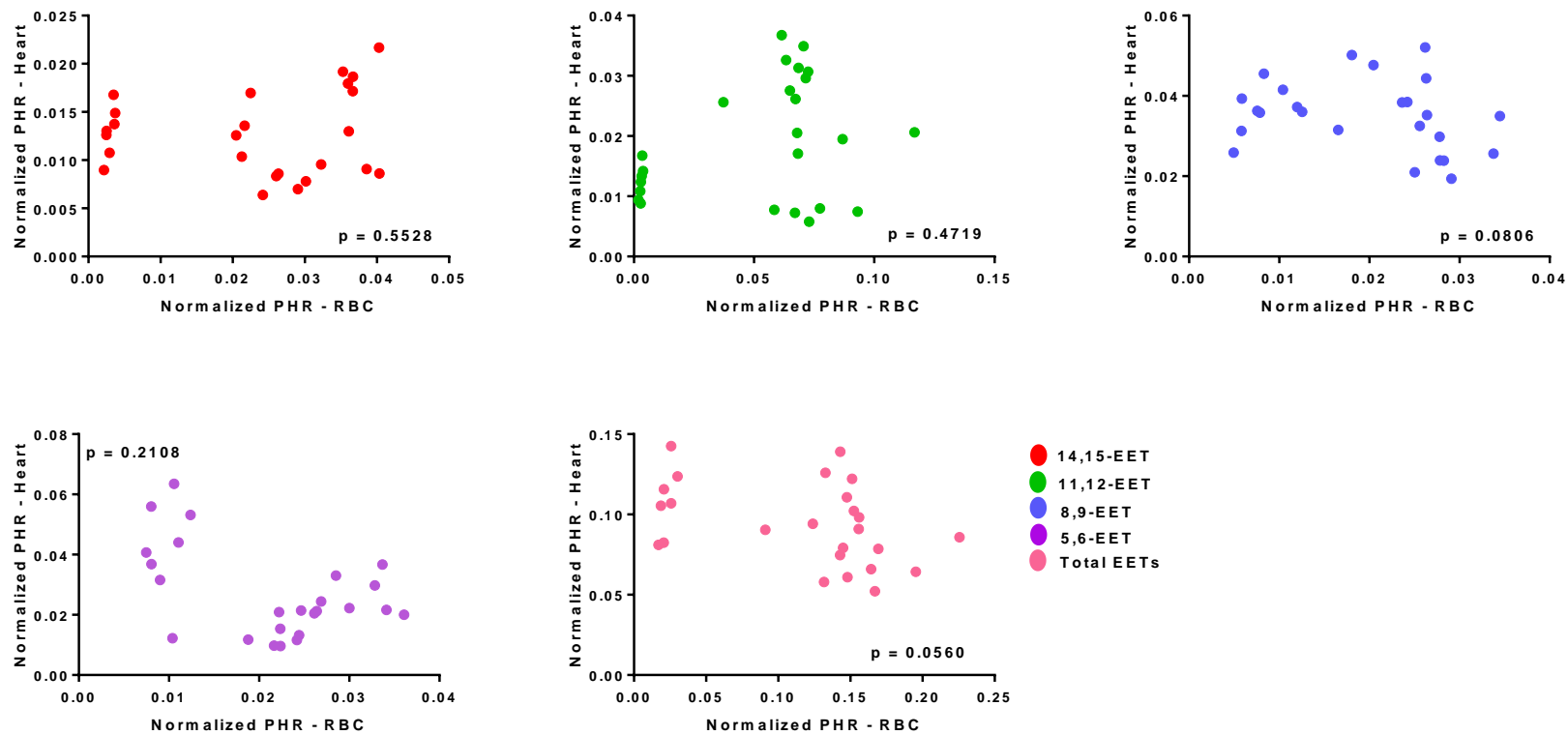
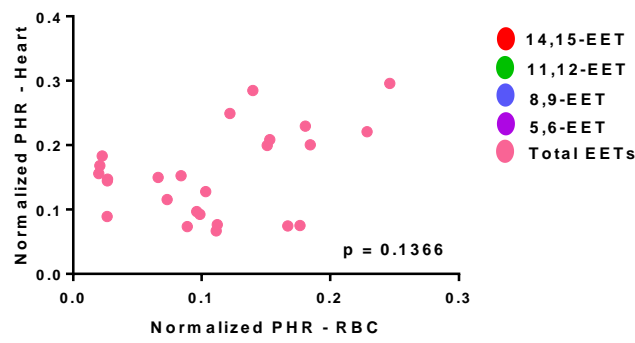
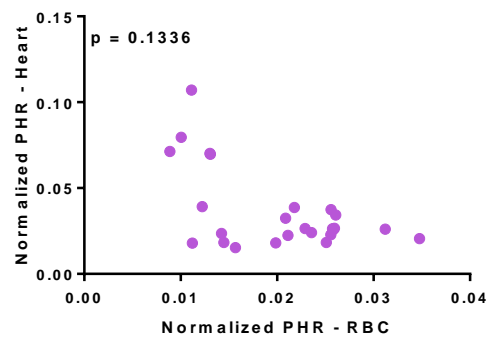
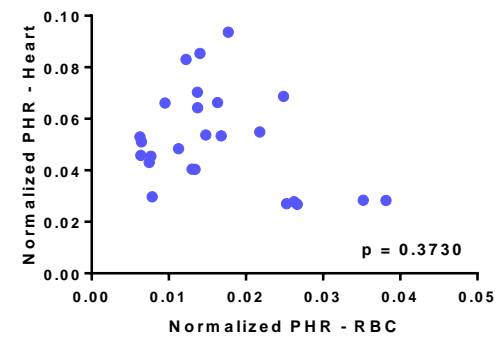
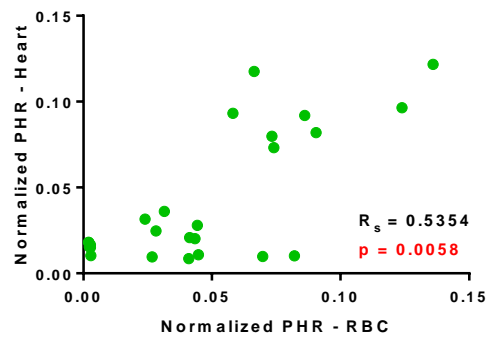
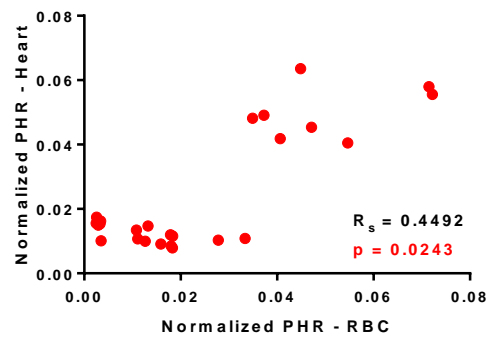


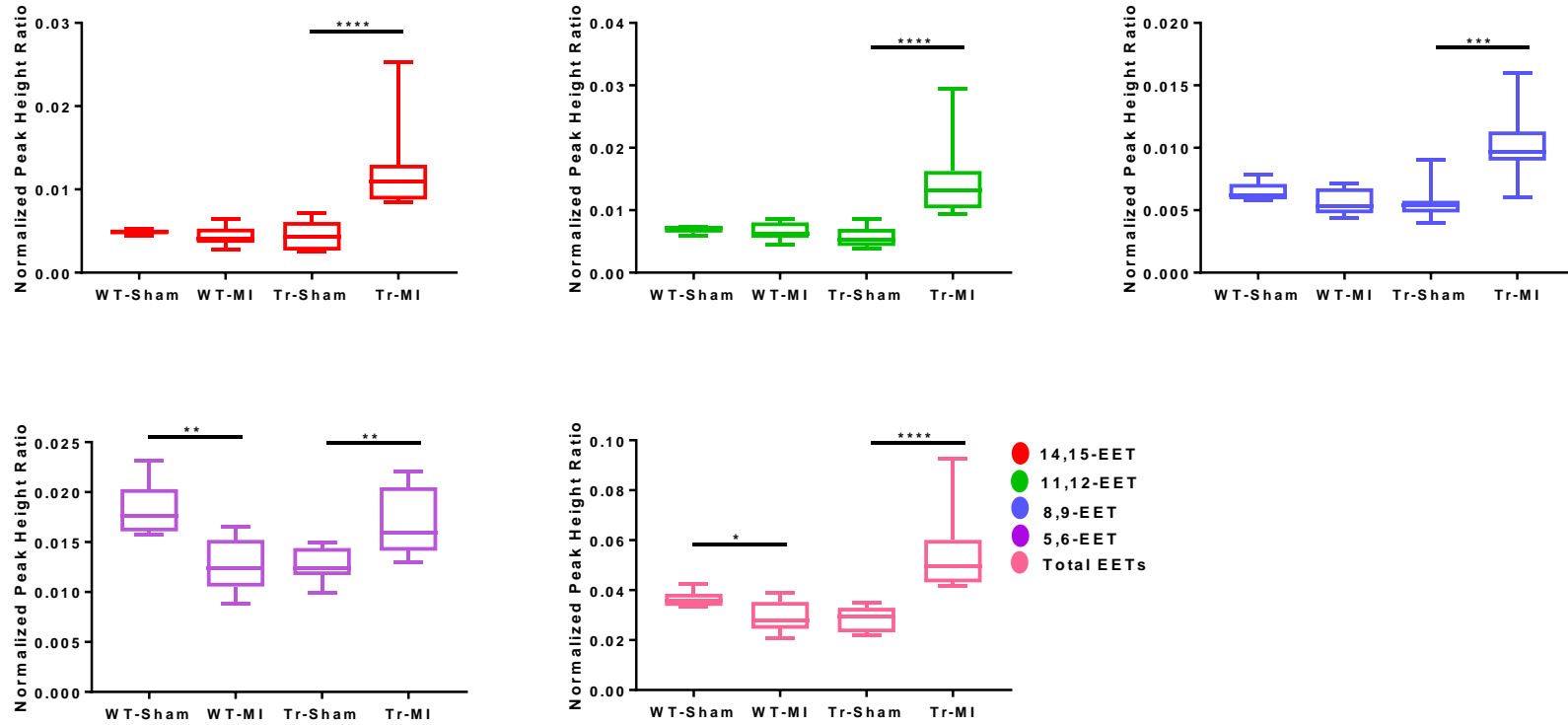

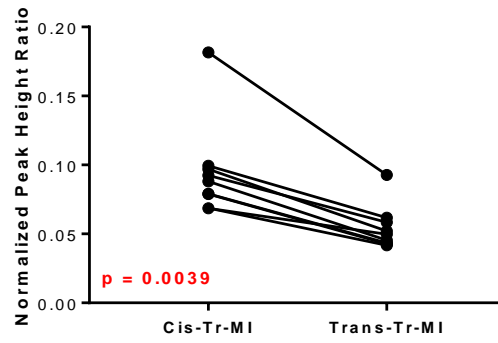
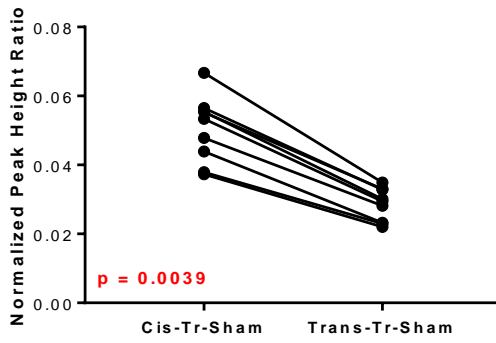
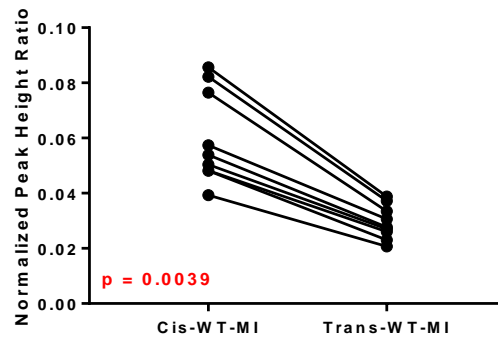
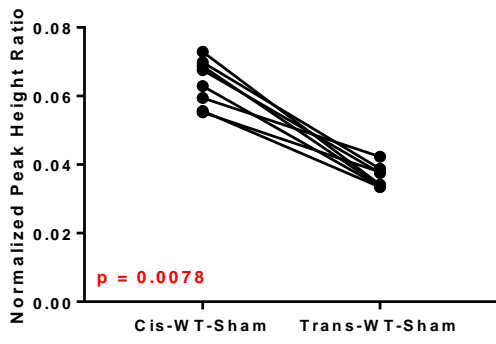

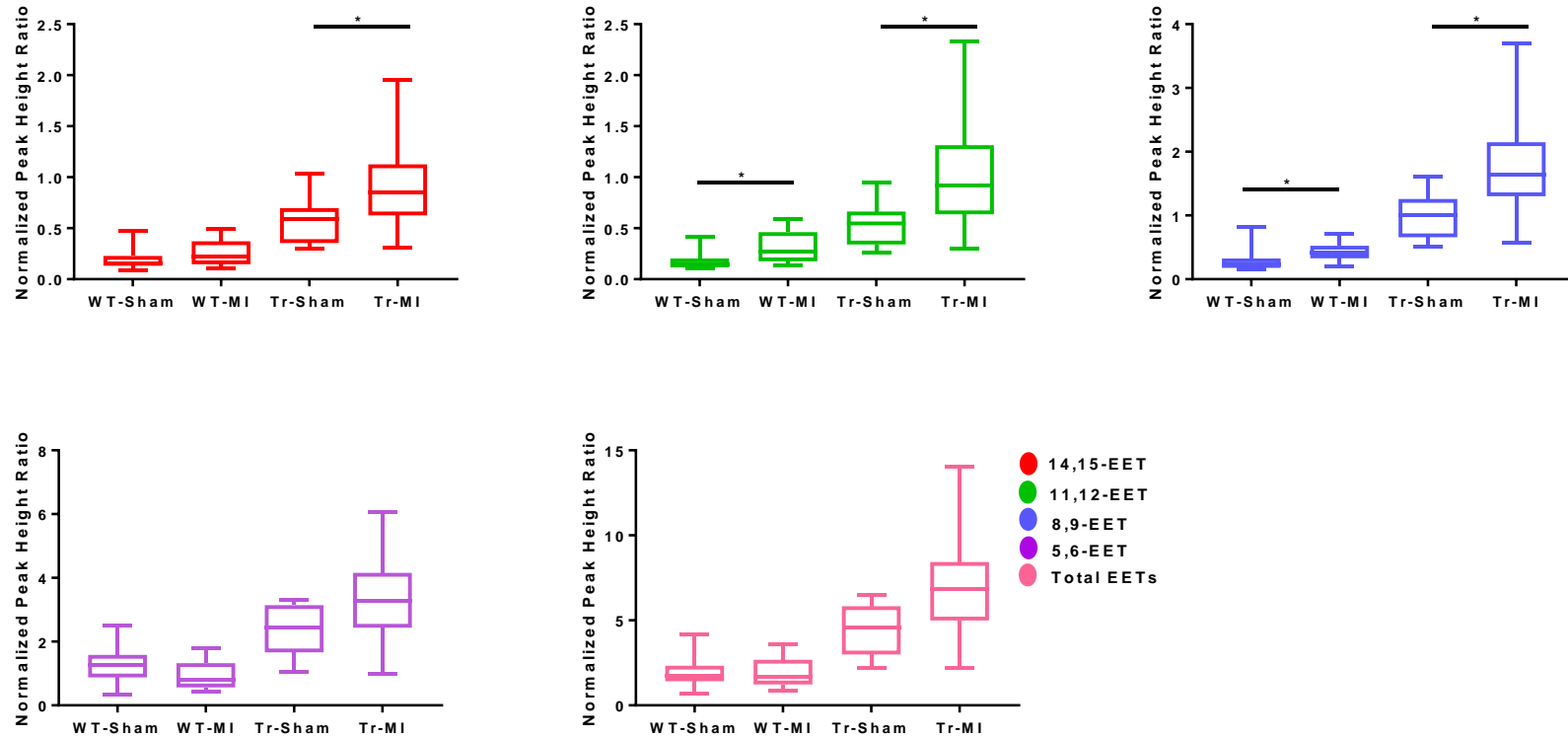

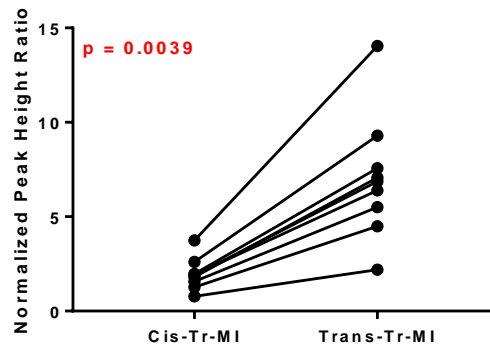
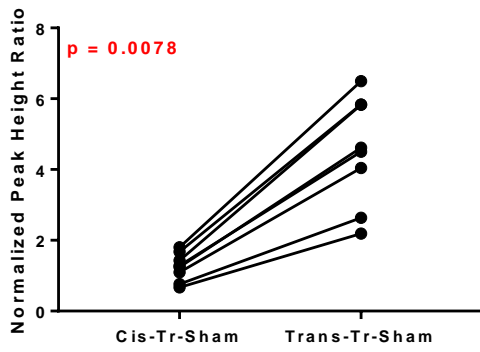
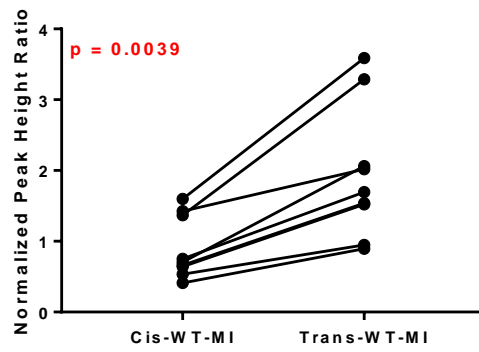
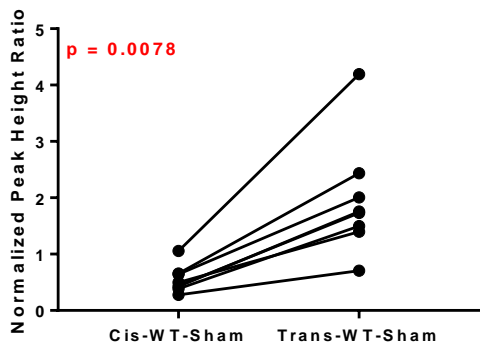

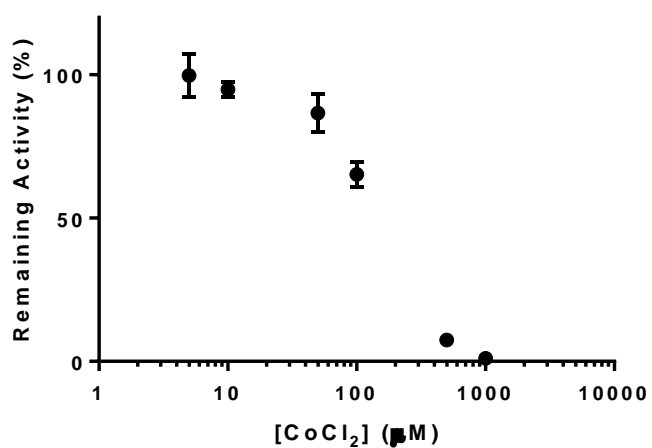
Supplementary Figure 4. Comparison between total *cis*- and *trans*-EETs levels extracted from erythrocyte membrane of WT and Tr mice.
