Figure S1. Graph of average jorō spider mass across the 20 different roads in this study. The roads are ordered by their traffic density (cars/day). There was significant variation in spider mass across roads (one-way ANOVA, $F_{17,341}=5.13$, $p<0.0001$), though there was no obvious trend with respect to traffic density.
