Message from the Guest Editors

Several studies have shown that plants are a source of a plethora of bioactive compounds, such as phytohormones, glycosides, terpenoids, alkaloids, phenolic compounds, and essential oils, with a strong potential impact in the fields of pharmaceutics and agriculture. These phytochemicals represent a valuable set of weapons that plants use in self-defense to counteract abiotic stresses disturbing the delicate equilibrium between the generation of reactive oxygen species (ROS) and antioxidant defense systems. These subjects were the main focus of our previous Special Issue, "Advances in the Astonishing World of Phytochemicals: State-of-the-Art for Antioxidants", which attracted the attention of many researchers and enjoyed a successful publication, with 17 papers being published in total.
