# Lymphocyte Signalling and Function in Systemic Autoimmune Diseases

### Message from the Guest Editor

The Special Issue "Lymphocyte Signalling and Function in Systemic Autoimmune Diseases" comprises novel research results on T- and B-cell abnormalities in systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE), Sjögren's syndrome, scleroderma, rheumatoid arthritis and other systemic autoimmune diseases. In recent years, several molecules of various intracellular signal transduction pathways have become accepted or promising therapeutic targets, Janus kinases being just one example. This Special Issue welcomes original research papers and comprehensive reviews about alterations in cell subset composition, novel T- and B-cell subsets, regulatory T- and B-cell function, intercellular communication including cytokine networks, adhesion molecules, immunological synapse function, and the mechanisms of intracellular signal transduction in response to antigenic or cytokine stimuli. Studies involving animal models and functional assays on human cells, including epigenetic regulation of gene expression, are welcome.
