Cardiometabolic disease is among the leading causes of morbidity and mortality worldwide and is a significant burden on the healthcare system. The use of highthroughput omics technologies has led to the rapid discovery of many candidate biomarkers. Systems biology integrated high-throughput multi-omics approach has been dedicated to understanding complete molecular biosignature of health and disease. Omics-based integrative identification and characterization of biomarker targets and their clinical translations are essential to developing comprehensive profiling, risk stratification, future cell-targeted early interventional and therapeutic strategies. This Special Issue will include the omics approaches such as genomics, transcriptomics, proteomics, lipidomics, or metabolomics to study the biological pathways and interaction at the cells and exosomes levels.
