Immune-Mediated Skin Diseases: Future Therapeutic Perspectives

Message from the Guest Editor

Immuno-mediated skin diseases are a common and clinically heterogeneous group of cutaneous conditions. In recent years, there has been a significant increase in the understanding of the pathogenesis of these diseases which are often difficult to treat. The therapeutic approaches for immune-mediated skin diseases have been transformed in the past two decades. We have moved from the utilization of broad-spectrum immune modulators to the use of agents with high specificity, arising from monoclonal and molecular biotechnology and, more recently, highly targeted small molecule synthesis. This Special Issue will focus on recent immunotherapy approaches and novel targeted therapy using bioactive small molecules for the treatment of immune-mediated skin diseases. Submissions of new research papers, reviews, commentaries and case reports are welcome to this Special Issue.
