Message from the Guest Editors

Our knowledge of biological membranes has substantially changed over the past several years, from the fluid mosaic idea to the current concept of lipids and proteins separating into microdomains that differ in their protein and lipid compositions. The role of lipids and membrane proteins is not limited to constituting the cell barrier. They are also involved in a wide range of processes including intracellular and extracellular transport, communication, cell migration, cell shape formation, and participation in the mechanisms of signal transduction that regulate cell function and homeostasis. Investigation of the world of membrane domains and the function of specific protein-lipid complexes has become possible thanks to the novel advanced tools used to study functions of diverse lipid classes in membranes with structural analysis and simulations at the atomic resolution. This Special Issue will highlight the importance of the membrane domains in protein-lipid interactions and the implications of this role on our understanding of the overall organization and functioning of cell membranes and their relation to myriad cellular outcomes.
