The effective removal of various organic pollutants is a major challenge in water, soil, and air treatment, Advanced chemical technologies (ACTs) have been considered a promising option because the highly reactive radicals such as hydroxyl, sulfate. chlorine, and carbon-centered radicals generated in ACTs can effectively oxidize a broad range of organic pollutants.
