Strategies for Access to Kidney Transplantation for Highly Sensitized and Incompatible Patients

Message from the Guest Editor

Historically, the lack of adequate strategies and powerful immunosuppressants make it impossible or an unacceptable risk level for kidney transplant in highly immunized patients or in the case of ABO incompatible pairs. The aim of this Special Issue is to describe new strategies and new drugs that allow for such high-risk transplantation. Several trials are, to date, ongoing and should be described in detail. We are soliciting papers describing these new drugs as well as new strategies. Strategies related to the Exchange Programmes (KEP) should also be the object of some papers. In particular, KEP allows transplantation between ABO incompatible pairs.
